PRELUDE

To each person, their own creativity is without limits.


When one discovers one's own limits and limitations, it can lead to despair as one does not see a way out any longer. Which, indeed, is the death of creativity.

Why Then / Now Now / Then Here / There There / Here






There is no right or wrong in art. Art is not about non-ambiguity.

Not more of the same but the other.


Leaning out of windows, we did not see before.


Constant refinement in seeing, watching, hearing, listening, moving, perceiving that, which is the other and what others made.

To unfold the time others condensed in their work.




















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
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
